<u>JOB</u>

DESCRIPTION:

This is a full-time, exempt, 204-day position. Responsibilities include performing evaluations of referred student's cognitive, academic, and social-emotional development in order to identify student strengths, administer psychological and educational tests to identify learning and/or behavioral differences in individual students, participate in the multi-disciplinary team process of student evaluations, assist in the development of the individual educational program by making placement, service and referral recommendations, follows-up on students' placement, adjustment and achievement by consulting with school staff, parents and outside service agencies, participate in staff and family training activities, utilizes and applies varied models and methods of assessment and data collection for identifying strengths and needs of individual students and the broader school community, developing effective services and programs and measuring progress and outcomes, develop and implement practices and strategies to create and maintain effective and supportive learning environments for children and others (e.g., positive behavior interventions and supports).

<u>MINIMUM</u>

QUALIFICATIONS:

A School Psychologist must complete a program in education which includes a Master's degree plus additional course work and an internship in school psychology (a minimum of 60 graduate semester hours of study and a 1,200 hours of supervised internship in School Psychology, with a minimum of 600 hours in a school setting).

SIGNING REQUIREMENTS:

The Sign Language Proficiency Interview (SLPI) for the position is "Advanced." The minimum level accepted at hire is "Advanced."

CLEARANCES REQUIRED:

PA Criminal Background, PA Child Abuse, and FBI Clearance required.
