<u>JOB</u> DESCRIPTION:

This is a part-time seasonal position. Responsibilities include establishing and maintaining safe training and participation guidelines, develop practice plans/training materials and conduct weekly practice sessions, communicate participation expectations and procedures to players and their parents, monitor team discord channel conversations, conduct Match Day confirmations and ingame contact as required by the League, provide Match Day in-person supervision for all regular season, playoff and finals matches, hold post-match team discussions to celebrate/promote improvement, coordinate with the Dean of Students/Athletic Director regarding practices and event logistics, provide information to the Dean of Students regarding equipment needs and condition, provide leadership and direction to Assistant Coaches/Volunteers to create a positive and engaging competitive learning environment for all participants, maintain professional image and promote good sportsmanship while coaching/competing.

QUALIFICATIONS:

The Head ESports Advisor should have a demonstrated knowledge and understanding of ESports Game Title.

SIGNING REQUIREMENTS:
